**Santa Fe Skate Fest 2007**

The 2007 Santa Fe Skate Fest will be conducted under the rules of US Figure Skating as set forth in the 2007 Official US Figure Skating Rule Book. This competition will be judged using the 6.0 system of judging. For information on the Skate Fest and Fun Fest, including schedules, visit the Santa Fe Skating Club's web-site at [www.santafeskatingclub.org](http://www.santafeskatingclub.org).

**ELIGIBILITY**

This competition is open to all eligible members of the US Figure Skating. Competition level is the highest free skating test passed as of the entry deadline. Skaters may skate at one level higher than tested for any event; it is not required to skate up for all events entered. Skaters who have not previously tested may also move up one level and compete at the pre-preliminary / pre-bronze level. Pre-Preliminary through Pre-Juvenile entries will be grouped by age. Juvenile and higher will be grouped as set forth in the 2007 Rulebook. Initial skating order will be determined by random draw. All competitors must comply with the US Figure Skating requirements relating to tests and eligibility.

**FACILITIES**

All events will be skated on one ice surface at the Genoveva Chavez Community Center (GCCC), located at 3221 Rodeo Road, Santa Fe, N.M. 87508. Phone 505/955-4000 (Information) or 505/955-4033 (skate shop). The ice surface is an indoor surface, standard NHL rink, 85 x 200 feet with rounded corners. The snack bar, along with other facility amenities, will be open during the competition.

**ENTRIES**

Entry and practice ice fees must accompany the completed approved entry application. Incomplete entries may warrant a collect telephone call to the entrant, and are not accepted until complete

\*NOTE: If a Skate Fest skater is participating in single events and has paid the first event fee of \$75.00, then the cost for the starred (\*) events will be charged as additional events. FunFest non-test entrants who choose to participate at test level in some Skate Fest artistic or duet events may pay for these events at the Skate Fest 'additional' event rate, rather than 'first' event rate.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to limit the entries for each event or to cancel an entire event due to time constraints. Entries will be processed on a "First Come, First Served" basis. Returned or stop-payment checks are subject to a \$25 charge for each check. A skater will not be allowed to skate until all fees, including the \$25 returned check charge, have been paid in full.

**All entries must be postmarked no later than April 5, 2007.** Please use the U.S. Postal Service; **we will not accept entries that require signature for delivery.** Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Chief Referee, and will be assessed a \$30 late fee. Any change after the close of entries will include the late fee. Incomplete applications are not considered entries until complete and may warrant a collect telephone call from the Competition Committee to obtain needed information. Two entries in an event will constitute a competition. Solo Dance and Couples Dance may be flighted due to time limitations. No entry fee will be refunded after April 5, 2007 unless the competition is not held or there is a death in the competitor's immediate family; no medical refunds will be given. A processing fee of \$20 will be assessed on all refunds unless the event is not held. If there is only one entrant in an event, the event may be combined with a similar event or the skater may choose to do an Exhibition, a Critique, or Skate against the Book without refund or have the event cancelled with refund. The Referee must know the skater's choice at least 2 weeks prior to May 17<sup>th</sup>.

## **LIABILITY**

US Figure Skating and the clubs or organizers of competitions undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skaters or officials. As a condition of, and in consideration of the acceptance of their entries or participation therein, all entrants, their parents and guardians and officials shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks of injury to their person or property resulting from, caused by or connected with the conduct and management of the competition, and to waive and release any and all claim which they may have against any officials, the US Figure Skating, the club hosting the competitions, against its officers, and the hosting facility (GCCC), and their entries shall be accepted only on such condition.

## **REGISTRATION**

The registration desk will be located in the entrance lobby of the GCCC and will be open at 12:00pm on Thursday May 17, 2007, and about 7:00am Friday through Sunday, closing at about 7:00pm, or earlier if competition-related activities for the day are finished. All entrants should check in when first arriving at the GCCC and during the allotted times. Entrants will need to turn in music for each of their events at time of check-in. Failure to do so could result in a competitor being ineligible to compete. Please be prepared to provide a telephone number where you (skater) can be reached during the competition in case of schedule changes outside the normal 45 minute pre-arrival period due to a competition schedule change.

## **PRACTICE ICE**

Practice Ice will be available on Thursday, May 17, 2007, but may be scheduled on another day or time depending on your competition schedule. The non-refundable charge for each pre-arranged session (fill out practice ice form) will be \$10.00. Each competitor who requests practice ice with entry will be guaranteed at least one session. Additional Practice Ice will be available throughout the competition on a first come, first served basis at a cost of \$12.00 per 30 minute session. You may sign up for any additional practice ice that is available at the Registration Desk located in the entrance lobby of the GCCC. Once practice ice has been scheduled, **NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE BY THE PRACTICE ICE COMMITTEE TO THE PRACTICE ICE SCHEDULE**, beyond assignment of additional practice, when space is available, for \$12.00 per 30 minute session. We will do everything we can to provide adequate ice, but be aware that we have only one ice surface. Practice Ice is limited to the day before the competition, and early morning/evening hours (as early as 5:00am and as late as 11:00pm). Skaters' practice times are assigned based on skating level and event types entered; this is a safety consideration. FunFest skaters will be assigned practice ice on Sunday morning, as early as 6:00 a.m. If it is determined that music can be played on practice ice, **skaters must use an extra copy of their music and the skating order is the result of a draw. Competition music will not be returned to the skater for practice.**

## **MUSIC**

Competitors must provide their own music. **ONLY CD's will be accepted –no tapes. CD's must be CD-R or CD-RW.** Each CD may only have one track on it. All music must be plainly marked with competitor's name and event and must be turned in at the time of registration. A backup must be readily available. A CD player will be available at the registration desk to make sure the disk works. It is the skater's responsibility to ensure that CD's will play properly. CD's may be picked up after the conclusion of each event. The Music Committee will take reasonable precautions to safeguard music; however, the Committee is not responsible for accidental damage.

## **AWARDS**

Awards will be presented as near as possible to the conclusion of each event. Check the Official Bulletin Board for schedule of times. Medals will be awarded to the top four (4) places in each event Pre-Preliminary and above. Medals will be awarded to all Fun Fest placements.

## **PHOTOGRAPHY**

Immediately after the awards presentations, professional photographs will be available for purchase. Spectators will be allowed to take photographs at the awards presentations, but are reminded that **flash photography is dangerous to the skaters while they are performing and will not be allowed during events.**

## **VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY/MEDAL ENGRAVING**

Professional video taping and photography by *Local Motion Productions* will be available for purchase. Medal engraving will also be available on site - time of operation will be posted.

## **OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD**

An Official Bulletin Board will be maintained at the arena. The Official Schedule will be posted, as well as the Practice Schedules. It is the responsibility of each competitor, coach and parent to check the Bulletin Board for official information. Any corrections to the schedule or other unique situations will be posted on this board. Skaters must arrive at least 45 minutes prior to their event(s).

## **OFFICIAL HOTELS**

## **COMPETITION EVENTS AND ELIGIBILITY**

Competitors may enter at their free skating level or one level above that for which they are qualified in any event. Competitors may not skate at a level lower than for which they are qualified, nor may they compete in more than one level in each event, with the exception of Solo Dance. Requirements for Dance and Pairs are listed below.

Event eligibility is as of April 5, 2007; age restricted events are determined by the skater's age as of April 5, 2007. Competitors must comply with US Figure Skating requirements relating to testing and eligibility. Pre Preliminary through PreJuvenile entries will be grouped by age. The competition committee reserves the right to combine Teen/Open events with Non Teen/Open events of the same level as well as Young Adult and Adult events, Ladies' and Men's events of the same level to make events.

## COMPULSORY MOVES

Test and age requirements are listed under Freeskating. Additional moves and unnecessary footwork will be penalized. Combination jumps may not have a change of foot or turn between jumps. No music. Committee may combine female and male entrants to make events.

Pre-Preliminary	Salchow, forward spiral, toe loop, one foot spin (min. 4 revs), connecting steps. Half ice. 1:00 (max).
Preliminary/ Teen Preliminary	Flip, jump combination consisting of two single jumps, sit spin (min. 4 revs), forward spiral, straight line steps. Flip should not be part of jump combination. Axel allowed. Half ice. 1:00 (max).
Pre-Juvenile/ Open Pre-Juvenile	Lutz, jump combination with two single jumps one of which is a loop. Combination spin, (min. 6 revs, no change of foot), Spread Eagle, Ina Bauer or forward spiral and connecting steps. Forward front scratch spin to back scratch spin combination-exit on spinning foot (min 3 rev. per foot); Camel spin (min. 3 rev.) Straight line footwork sequence. Axel allowed. Half ice. 1:30 (max).
Juvenile/ Open Juvenile	Axel, jump combination with a double-single or single-double combination. Sit change sit spin (min 4 revs each foot); layback spin (ladies), camel spin (men) (min. of 4 revs) Straight line footwork sequence. 1:30 (max). Full ice.
Young Adult/Adult Pre Bronze	Salchow, forward spiral, half flip, one foot spin with no change of position (min. 4 revs) and connecting steps. 1:00. Half ice.
Young Adult/Adult Bronze	½ lutz, loop, combination jump with two single jumps; <b>axel not allowed</b> . One foot spin (min. 4 revs), camel spin (min. 3 revs) and connecting steps. 1:30. Half ice.

Young Adult/Adult Silver	Salchow, loop, combination jump with two single jumps. Camel spin (min. 4 revs). Combination spin with one change of foot and at least one change of position. Straight line footwork sequence. Axel allowed. 1:30. Half ice.
Young Adult/Adult Gold	Axel, lutz, double loop, one combination jump with a single-double jump combination or two double jumps, sit spin (min. 5 revs). Backward spiral. Straight line, circular or serpentine footwork sequence. 1:30 Full ice.

**SPIN COMPETITION**

Entrants qualify according to their Freeskating level. Spins must be skated exactly as stated, but may be performed in any order. Connecting steps are not to be included and will not affect your score. All levels will be skated on half ice with no music. Committee may combine male and female entrants to make events.

Pre-Preliminary	One foot spin optional free leg (3 revs); two foot spin (3 revs); forward sit spin (3 revs). 1:30 max.
Preliminary/ Teen Preliminary	Forward sit spin (3 revs); one foot upright back spin (3 revs); forward camel spin (3 revs). 1:30 max.
Pre-Juvenile/ Open Pre-Juvenile	Camel spin (4 revs); change foot sit spin (4 revs each foot); front to back scratch (4 revs each foot). 1:30 max.
Juvenile/ Open Juvenile	Flying camel spin (5 revs), change foot sit spin (5 revs each foot), 1 combination spin with only 1 change of foot and only one change of position (4 revs each foot). 1:30 max.
Intermediate	Change foot sit spin (5 revs each foot), camel spin to back camel spin (5 revs each foot), combination spin consisting of only 1 change of foot and 2 changes of position (5 revs each foot). 1:30 max.
Novice	Forward camel spin (6 revs), combination spin with 1 change of foot and 2 changes of position (15 revs total). Ladies: layback spin (6 revs) Men: cross foot spin (6 revs). 1:30 max.
Junior	Flying sit spin (6 revs), combination spin with 3 changes of position and only 1 change of foot (5 revs each foot), Ladies layback (6 revs), Men: cross foot spin (6 revs). 1:30 max.
Senior	Flying spin of choice (6 revs); combination spin with two changes of position and two changes of foot 15 revs total); solo (not combination) spin of skater's choice (8 revs). 1:30 max.
Young Adult/ Adult	Attitude or camel spin (4 revs), forward sit spin (4 revs), Spin combination with 1 change of foot and/or 1 change of position (total of 8 revs). 1:30 max.

## DANCE

**Each dance will be a separate event.** Preliminary through Gold will be offered. Competitors may enter any level above their test level, but cannot enter below their test level. Committee may combine male and female, standard, adult and masters entrants in order to make events.

## ARTISTIC FREESKATING

Artistic Free Skating is offered for Pre-Preliminary and above. Dramatic and light events will be offered at each level. Emphasis is on artistry rather than athletic ability of the skater. Skaters select their own music and interpret its theme and tempo. Costumes are encouraged, but must comply with costume rules. Vocal music permitted. Props may be placed on the ice during the event. This is a "FUN" event ...we encourage everyone to participate. Committee may combine male and female, dramatic and light events in order to make events. Skaters placing fourth and higher in preliminary and higher artistic solo events, including adult events, will be qualified to enter the next National Showcase. National Showcase contestants must also be qualified by test level. Duets and production ensembles are not required to qualify for National Showcase. Elements	Skating will be judged solely on artistic value. Levels may be combined at the discretion of the Chief Referee to make a competition. Technical skill not marked; however, skating must be the major element of performance.

## ARTISTIC FREESKATING-DUETS

No test requirements. Emphasis is on artistry and theater rather than athletic ability of the skaters. Skaters select their own music (vocals allowed). Costumes are encouraged. Only props that are part of the theme and not a safety hazard will be allowed. There must be no debris, live props, fire or water. Any two eligible skaters may enter as a duet: duets may be segregated by the test level of the highest ranked member or combined to make logical events. **Max. 1:40.**

## **FUN FEST COMPETITION**

The purpose of the Fun Fest Competition is to promote a fun, competitive introduction into the sport of figure skating. Skaters **MUST BE** members of US Figure Skating through a club or as an individual member. The competition is open to all beginner skaters who are either enrolled in a class program or private instruction. Skaters who have passed the USFS Pre-Preliminary Free Skating test or higher, or skaters who have entered the Santa Fe Skate Fest at a Pre-Preliminary Level, with the exception of Artistic events, are **NOT** eligible.

## **ENTRY FEES**

The entry fee is \$45 for the first event and \$20 for each additional event. Make separate **check payable to: Santa Fe Skating Club. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope (with skater's name on outside) to obtain a schedule of your competition and Practice Ice times.**
